Revenge (Game Mode 1)

Setup

Thoroughly shuffle all three Assassins into your dungeon deck. Place a dungeon of any size you choose, such as 4×4 or 3×3, as long as there is a two-dungeon-card hallway evenly spaced between both players' deployment zones.

(P1 Deployment Zone)



(2 Card Hallway)



Regular gameplay and deck rules are unchanged, and everything proceeds the same in terms of turns, except each player draws 2 gems per turn, as opposed to 1.

(P2 Deployment Zone)

Hallways can be any length the player chooses. Remember to have fun when building your dungeon, as long as the hallway is evenly spaced between each player in the lair. Games may also include more than two players, provided the hallway and exit dungeon rooms are equally accessible to every player entering the lair.

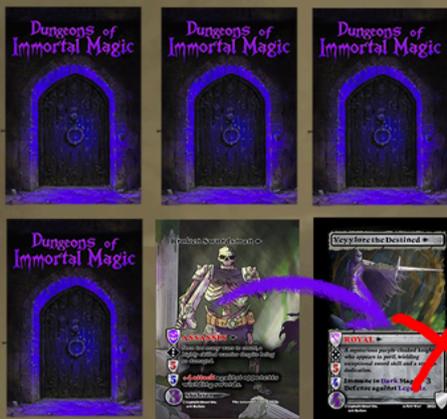
Revenge (Game Mode 1)

Gameplay

Gameplay is fairly simple. Players search the dungeon for the Assassins. When an Assassin is revealed by a character, that character is killed instantly (assassinated). The Assassin then remains revealed and, on each turn, moves toward the nearest player character. Assassins attack player characters using normal combat rules. If multiple characters are equally distant, dice rolls may be used to determine movement.

Each Assassin carries a token (any marker may be used, such as soul counters). The goal of each player is to kill an Assassin, claim its token, and then exit the dungeon through the hallway. Note that the hallway cannot be accessed at any point during the game until this condition is met. Even if a player is carrying a token, a revealed Assassin will still instantly kill any character that reveals it.

This game mode focuses heavily on strategy, with players fighting both each other's armies and the Assassins.



The card shown on the left has revealed an Assassin and is instantly killed. The Assassin remains revealed and then proceeds toward the nearest character on the next turn.

(Dungeon is bigger than the one shown)

Other Assassin's Lair dungeon cards can be added to enhance dungeon exploration and create more engaging battles. Now that you know how to play, enjoy the Assassin's Lair!
